

FRASER COAST OUTRIGGER CANOE CLUB INC.

CLUB BY-LAWS

as at 10th September 2010

1. Canoes to be placed on tyres when in compound.
2. Canoes not to be beached when travelling towards the beach at sprint pace.
3. Two bailing buckets to be in each canoe at all times.
4. Do not paddle while intoxicated (drugs or alcohol)
5. All members are responsible for keeping the Club compound and Maryborough Sailing Club clean after use.
6. Keys for compound and Maryborough Sailing Club are to be signed for and a deposit paid before being released by Club Captain. Keys to remain the property of the Club.
7. Canoes can only be used within the Hervey Bay Region and sanctioned regattas unless otherwise approved by the Management Committee
8. Lights to be used when training in darkness.
9. Full comprehensive insurance must be in place over any vehicle used to tow boat trailer.
10. Club paddling year commences on 1st October each year.
11. All annual fees must be paid in full by 30th of September each year. Where part fees are paid, access to club equipment and facilities will be suspended at this date until such times as payment is made in full.
12. Half yearly membership fees will be 50% of a full years membership and will be available from the 1st of April each year.
13. New paddlers and paddlers who have not been members of any outrigger club within the past 2 years will receive three free paddle session prior to becoming a financial member.
14. Annual Club Awards will comprise of, Senior Club Person of the Year, Junior Club Person of the Year, Senior Paddler, Junior Padder, Senior Club Champion, Junior Club Champion, Senior Novice paddler, Jnr Encouragement Award.
15. No funds or sponsorship can be raised on behalf of the Club or it's members without prior approval by the Management Committee.
16. A 80/20 percentage break up, Team/Club, is in force regarding individual Team fundraising, excluding sponsorship. This split converts to 90/10 when funds are specifically raised by Teams to attend overseas outriggering events.
17. Sitting Management Committee (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Club Captain) are ineligible for Club Person of the Year Award, Paddler of the Year Award and Novice Paddler of the Year Award.
18. Clothing with the club name or logos must be approved by the Management Committee prior to order.

19. No 1st Year/Novice paddler can take out club canoes onto the water without an experienced paddler or coach.

20. All OC6 canoes are to be floated on and off the trolleys, into and from the water unless weather conditions make it unsafe to do so.
